IT-030 plays a leading role in the development of governance and IT service management standards, and more recently in business process outsourcing standardisation. Members are acknowledged for their thought leadership and involvement in creating principles-based standards. They recently published AS/NZS 8016:2013 *Governance of IT enabled projects* – a significant new standard that supports governance leaders in successfully guiding major information technology (IT).

A new standard is also under development for the Governance of Benefits Realisation for IT-Enabled Investments. Standards such as these provide vital guidance for directors, managers and ICT leaders and the promotion of standards is of importance to Australia's competitive efficiency.

Standards Australia's technical committee IT-030 ICT Governance and Management was constituted by Standards Australia to develop national and international standards in governance, IT service management and business process outsourcing. IT-030 is also the national mirror committee for ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 40 IT Service Management and IT Governance. ISO/IEC JTC 1 is the Joint Technical Committee of ISO and IEC focusing on standardisation in the field of ICT for business and consumer applications.

The ICT Governance and Management Committee includes representatives from the Australian Computer Society, Australian Industry Group, Australian Information Industry Association, Council of Small Business of Australia, Governance Institute of Australia, Institute of Company Directors, ISACA, Project Management Institute, and State and Federal Governments.
