Q: Tell us how long you have been in IT what is your current position and what led you to the occupation?

I still leverage ISACA as an avenue for being aware of current cybersecurity and IT auditing trends.

Q: What other roles have you held?

A: While I was with the ISACA Los Angeles Chapter, I served as the marketing chair and served on the spring conference committee. At the ISACA Maryland Chapter, I'm taking on the role of assistant webmaster.
