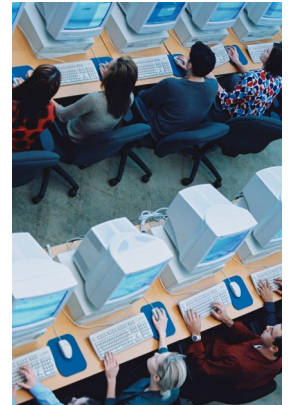

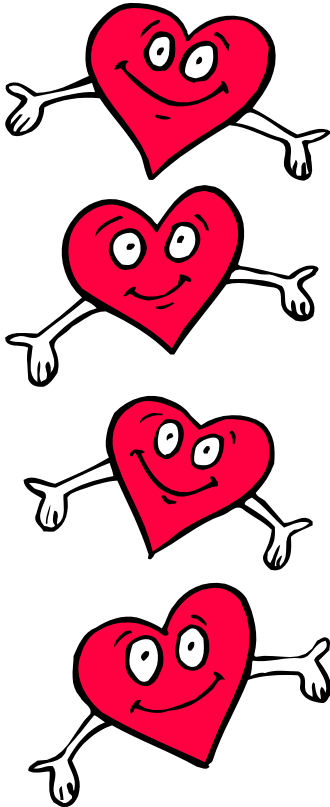
Training in the Region

Updates from the Board

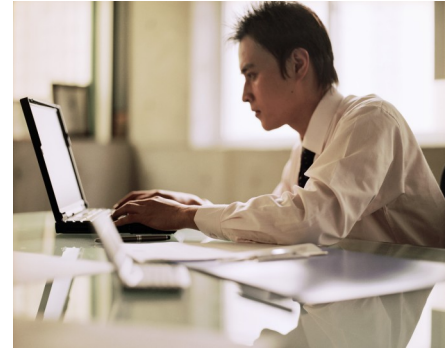

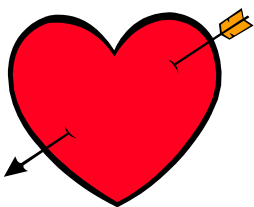
