Insights: Cybersecurity Attack Simulation

Cybersecurity attack simulation can be used to identify, enumerate, and prioritize incident response strategy based on specific scenarios. The purpose of cyber attack simulation is to provide defenders with a systematic analysis of the probable attacker's entry point, the most likely attack vectors, and the assets most desired by an attacker. Cyber attack simulation answers the questions "How and what is happening behind the scene of a cyber attack?" "Which part of my infrastructure is most vulnerable to attack?" "What are the most relevant defense options that I have?" "Is there an attack vector that might go unnoticed?"

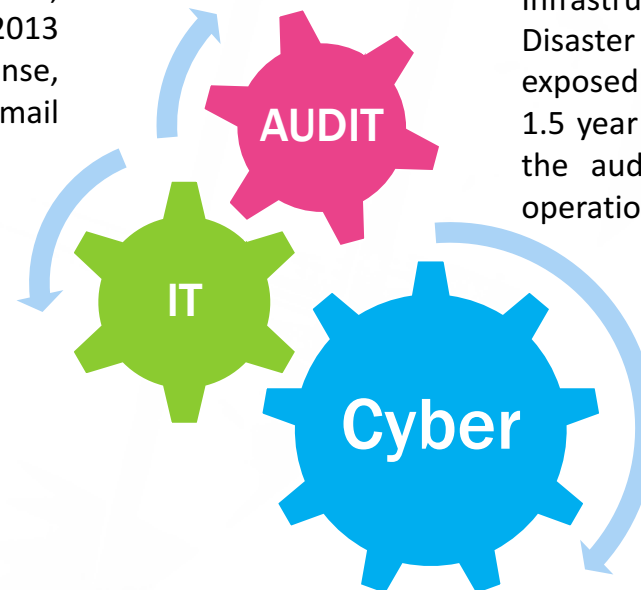
