



CYBERSECURITY AUDIT CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FACT SHEET

ISACA's new [Cybersecurity Audit Certificate Program](#) provides audit/assurance professionals with the knowledge needed to excel in cybersecurity audits. It provides security professionals with an understanding of the audit process, and IT risk professionals with an understanding of cyber-related risk and mitigating controls.

The Certificate Program includes:

- **A choice of three training approaches:**
 - Online course
 - Virtual instructor-led training
 - On-site training via ISACA Training Weeks, events or workshops
- **A companion study guide:**
 - This guide introduces candidates to cybersecurity and audit's role, cybersecurity governance, and cybersecurity operations.
- **Cybersecurity Audit Certificate Exam Voucher:**
 - This voucher allows the candidate to take the online and remote-proctored Cybersecurity Audit Certificate exam, which can be taken at the candidate's convenience. Candidates who pass the exam will receive a certificate and digital badge.

Through the Cybersecurity Audit Certificate Program, participants will learn more than a dozen skills, including:

- Understanding security frameworks to identify best practices
- Defining threat and vulnerability management
- Assessing threats with the help of vulnerability management tools
- Building and deploying secure authorization processes
- Explaining all aspects of cybersecurity governance
- Distinguishing between firewall and network security technologies
- Enhancing asset, configuration, change and patch management practices
- Managing enterprise identity and information access
- Identifying application security controls
- Identifying cyber and legal regulatory requirements to aid in compliance assessments
- Identifying weaknesses in cloud strategies and controls
- Performing cybersecurity and third-party risk assessments
- Identifying the benefits and risks of containerization
