### **TOP 10 LARGEST SECURITY BREACHES OF 2014**

According to iDigitalTimes, the top 10 largest security breaches of 2014 in order of total records breached were:

- 1) Ebay - 145 million
- 2) J.P. Morgan Chase - 76 million
- 3) Home Depot - 56 million
- 4) Community Health Systems - 4.5 million
- 5) Michaels - 2.6 million

- 6) Texas Health And Human Services - 2 million
- 7) Neiman Marcus - 1.1 million
- 8) Goodwill Industries - 868,000
- 9) Oregon Employment Department - 850,000
- 10) US Postal Service - 800,000

SONY ranked 33 on the list with 47,000 total records breached.

### [Demand for mobile biometrics to skyrocket](#)

According to a report recently published by Acuity Market Intelligence, growing demand for smartphones, tablets and wearable devices that incorporate biometric features is expected to drive a global market of 2.5 billion users with nearly 4.8 billion biometric devices in use by 2020.
