### New York Metro Joint Cyber Security Conference



The New York Metro Joint Cyber Security Conference (NYMJCS) will hold its inaugural annual cyber security conference at St Francis College, Brooklyn, NY on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014. The New York Metro Joint Cyber Security Conference is the first collaborative event cooperatively developed, organized and sponsored by the local chapters of the leading information security industry organizations - ISACA, ISSA, (ISC)<sup>2</sup>, InfraGard, OWASP and the Cloud Security Alliance.

This joint conference has the additional advantage from the relationship with the FBI and National Security Council. Keynote speakers [Leo Taddeo, Special Agent in Charge, FBI NY Cyber Crime Division; and Nathaniel Gleicher, Director for Cybersecurity on the National Security Council] will lead discussions on emerging trends in cybersecurity. Real world threats, landscapes, and techniques will be presented in both a local and global climate that result in actionable intelligence.

Driven by the collaboration between members of this coalition, the strength of organizational membership, the provision of desirable CPE credits and the concurrence of National Cyber Security Awareness Month - the NYMJCS promises to be a well-attended event by members of the information technology, information security, audit, academic, and business communities.

***CRISC Job Practice***

The CRISC job practice and CRISC certification requirements will change with the June 2015 CRISC exam administration. Details will be posted on the ISACA® web site in the coming months. The December 2014 exam will be the last exam covering the current CRISC job practice. Please encourage those individuals who have been studying the current CRISC job practice to register for and take the December 2014 exam.

Registration for the December exam is located on the [Exam Registration](#) page of the ISACA® web site. The final registration deadline is October 24, 2014.

### **2009 Exam Passers**

Exam passers have 5 years to apply for certification once they have passed an exam. All certification requirements are to be met within these 5 years. The 5-year period to apply for certification for those who passed the exam in 2009 will end on December 31, 2014. Exam passers are not certified and cannot use the CISA, CISM, CGEIT or CRISC designation until their completed application is received and approved by ISACA®.
