The ISACA New York Metropolitan Chapter invites full time college students to participate in the 2016 Student Competition. Our competition will provide our students with simulated real world experience.

The student competitors will solve a Security Audit case study using a website and network analysis tools, and document their Security Audit findings. The findings documentation will be reviewed by a panel of four independent judges who will identify the finalists based on the accuracy and completeness of their findings documentation. Finalists will present their findings in person at which time the competition winners will be selected.

All participants who complete the Competition (i.e., submit findings documentation) will receive a participation certificate, CPE credit, and recognition in the Chapter newsletter and Chapter website.

AUDITING UNIX/LINUX- December 8-9, 2016
